Ainoa – Wines crafted from the Finnish forest

Ainoa was founded by two immigrants who came to Finland with the ambition to make exceptional wine from ingredients that grow far from traditional vineyards. They soon discovered what their many international awards now confirm: the Finnish forest offers some of the most remarkable winemaking ingredients in the world.

Working in Hollola, Ainoa crafts wines from berries and flowers shaped by long summer days, cold winters and the clarity of the northern landscape. Many of the berries come straight from the wild, hand-picked by trusted farmers and pickers. For Ainoa, the forest is their vineyard - and you can taste the difference.

Their approach blends modern technique with patience and respect for tradition. Slow fermentation, gentle handling and careful ageing allow each berry's natural character to unfold into wines with depth, elegance and authenticity.

Today, Ainoa continues to redefine what Finnish wine can be. Their creations capture the essence of Finland: clarity, purity and quiet confidence - a taste of the forest, the light and the Finnish summer in every glass.

Champagne



Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut, MV

Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier
Châlons-en-Champagne, France.

Dry and elegant. A symbol of the know-how of maison Joseph Perrier, Cuvée Royale Brut embodies the elegance and balance that define their champagne. Its name pays tribute to the House's historical ties with the British royal courts in the 19th century, reflecting a refined and timeless style. A harmonious blend of the three Champagne grape varieties chardonnay, pinot noir, and meunier—this cuvée delights with its freshness, finesse, and aromatic complexity.

White wine



Altos de Torona Albariño, 2024

Albariño
Rías Baixas, Spain.

Dry and fresh. Light yellow with greenish reflections, this Albariño shows aromas of Reineta apple, citrus, apricot and subtle toasted notes from ageing on fine lees. The palate is mouth filling, saline and oily with controlled acidity and a smooth, lingering aftertaste.



Château Villa Bel-Air Blanc, 2023

Sauvignon Blanc, Sémillon
Graves, Bordeaux, France. AOC Graves

Dry and rich. Full bodied and aromatically complex Graves white. Notes of peach, mirabelle plum, exotic fruit and delicate florals lead to citrus zest and a refreshing hint of bitterness. The palate shows both density and lift, supported by balanced acidity. Fermented in oak barrels and aged on lees for added finesse.



Domäne Gobelsburg Riesling, 2024

Riesling
Niederösterreich, Austria

Dry and vibrant. A classic Austrian Riesling with crisp citrus, stone fruit and lively acidity. Sourced from terraced Kamptal vineyards—including young vines from Heiligenstein and Gaisberg—this wine shows spirited freshness, fine aroma, light yet firm texture and a brisk, clean finish.

Rose wine



Pavillon de Montfleur

Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah
Provence, France. AOC Côteaux d'Aix en Provence.

Dry and elegant. A beautifully coloured rosé with delicate notes of wild strawberries, peaches and pink grapefruit. The palate is fresh and refined, offering flavours of ripe citrus, redcurrant and a hint of watermelon. A gentle, almost creamy texture balances the bright acidity, finishing long, crisp and mineral. Crafted in the sun kissed hills of Provence, this wine reflects the region's elegance and Mediterranean charm.

Red wine



Torre Raone Montepulciano
d'Abruzzo, 2022

Montepulciano
Abruzzo, Italy. DOC

Medium-bodied and smooth. Ripe red cherry, plum and gentle spice define this organically produced Montepulciano. Soft tannins and balanced acidity give it a velvety, harmonious mouthfeel. A clean, fruit-forward finish highlights the purity achieved through organic viticulture.



Château Villa Bel-Air Rouge, 2022

Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc
Graves, Bordeaux, France. AOC Graves

Full-bodied and elegant. Beautifully mature aromas of red fruits, subtle spice and a delicate floral note. The palate is long, aromatic and fruit driven with fine tannins and a fresh, balanced structure shaped by the warm, dry growing season.



Vizar Prestigio, 2019

Tempranillo, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah
Castilla y León, Spain

Full-bodied and velvety. Deep and bright in colour, this wine reveals elegant and complex aromas of blackberry, blueberry, violets and warm spices such as black pepper, cloves and liquorice. The palate is generous and silky with a persistent, harmonious finish. Aged 16 months in French oak.

Ainoa "Kaste"

Lingonberry, honey, meadowsweet
Hollola, Finland

Sweet and lightly sparkling. Floral and bright, with notes of lingonberry, honey and wild meadow herbs. Gently effervescent and refreshing, capturing the character of a Finnish summer forest. Crafted from lingonberries and honey, infused with meadowsweet, and finished with delicate Charmat method sparkle.



Madame de Rayne, 2018

Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc
Bordeaux, France. AOC Sauternes

Sweet and lively. Fresh notes of pineapple and grapefruit lead into a smooth, rounded palate with ripe peach and pear. Hand-picked botrytised grapes and gentle oak ageing bring elegance, balance and youthful liveliness - a bright and modern expression of Sauternes.
