


For two centuries, the Champagne house has remained a family-owned gem, rooted in tradition while always keeping an eye on the future. To honor this remarkable anniversary, the *maison* celebrated in true Joseph Perrier style—authentic, generous, and forward-looking...

That future began to take shape in 2024, when Joseph Perrier unveiled a complete rebranding ahead of its bicentenary. This refreshed identity was conceived as a gift to mark the 200th anniversary, a way to bridge the *maison's* heritage with the expectations of a new generation of wine lovers. With cleaner lines, a modern aesthetic, and storytelling that highlights both its terroirs and its family legacy, the new brand look brings greater clarity while preserving the authenticity that defines Joseph Perrier.



1825 - 2025

The maison Joseph Perrier celebrates 200 years of a unique family adventure driven by the ambition to create cuvées of excellence.

To celebrate our anniversary, we drew inspiration from our historical heritage, in particular the tradition of working with renowned poster artists. Benjamin Fourmon, 6th generation, chose the talented illustrator Jean-Michel Tixier to create the bicentenary poster.

Jean-Michel's passion for champagne and his artistic talent have combined to create a striking work, capturing the essence of two centuries of history.

In his creation, Jean-Michel Tixier plays with the codes of our *maison* and its founder Joseph Perrier to bring an amusingly offbeat twist to the 200th anniversary.



Champagne

Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut MV

Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier
Châlons-en-Champagne, France

Dry and elegant. A symbol of the know-how of maison Joseph Perrier, Cuvée Royale Brut embodies the elegance and balance that define their champagne. Its name pays tribute to the House's historical ties with the British royal courts in the 19th century, reflecting a refined and timeless style. A harmonious blend of the three Champagne grape varieties chardonnay, pinot noir, and meunier—this cuvée delights with its freshness, finesse, and aromatic complexity. Carefully aged in their Gallo-Roman cellars, it reveals a beautiful maturity and delicate effervescence, making it the perfect companion for any moment of enjoyment.



White wines

Château de Targé, T de Targé, 2024

Sauvignon Blanc
Loire, France. AOC Touraine

Dry and fresh. Bouquet is powerful and complex, revealing several aromatic profiles. The flavours are pronounced with notes of grapefruit, caramelized orange and mango. Touraine appellation is in Middle Loire and vineyards close to river Loire. Loire is famous for its Chenin Blancs and Sauvignon Blancs.



Deux Roches Mâcon-Villages "Tradition", 2023

Chardonnay
Bourgogne, France. AOP Mâcon-Villages

Dry and rich. Fresh and expressive with notes of white flowers, peaches and citrus. Gently matured to gain extra smoothness and depth. Balanced acidity lifts the clean, elegant finish. The Mâconnais can also pride itself on being reputed as the birthplace of Chardonnay.



Schloss Reinhartshausen Hattenheimer, 2024

Riesling
Rheingau, Germany. QmP Kabinett Feinherb

Medium-dry and fruity. This organic wine has delicate aromas of apples, apricots and black currants. Playful acidity balances the sweetness nicely. Chateau Schloss Reinhartshausen has been a pillar of Rheingau wine culture for 680 years. They work strictly according to ecological principles with nature and fauna. They have been certified organic winery since 2021. Organic.



Red wines

Quinta do Crasto Superior, 2022

Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Sousão
Douro, Portugal. DOC Douro

Full-bodied and velvety. Vibrant and sophisticated aromas reveal a balanced combination of wild berries and a touch of spices. Firm, yet perfectly polished tannins with rich and velvety texture continue to long and distinctive finish. Aged 12 months in French oak barrels. Quinta do Crasto dates far back into ancient times. The name Crasto comes from the Latin castrum meaning "Roman fort". Vegan.



Château Puybarbe Côtes de Bourg, 2019

Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Malbec
Bordeaux, France. AOP Côtes de Bourg

Full-bodied and elegant. This wine presents classic Bordeaux style with elegant tannins and dark ripe fruitiness. Aromas of ripe blackberries with a hint of smokiness in the end. Riku and Anna Väänänen are a Finnish couple who left their corporate careers in Switzerland to pursue their passion for winemaking in the renowned Côtes de Bourg region of Bordeaux. Vegan.



Dogliani Il Generale Barbera D'Alba, 2023

Barbera
Piedmont, Italy. DOC

Medium-bodied and vibrant. Vivid cherry and plum notes with a hint of spice. Bright acidity, with hints of vanilla and toasted oak. The tannins are soft and well-integrated. True to its northern Italian roots, it's medium-bodied with fresh acidity and smooth tannins. The story of the Dogliani family starts more than 150 years ago, when in 1856 the "Generale" Domenico Dogliani decided to turn his passion into a job.



Dessert wines

Ainoa "Valokki"

Cloudberry
Hollola, Finland

Sweet and unique. Made of Finnish cloudberry, aged four months before bottling. Golden-yellow and sweet, this wine features bright acidity with notes of cloudberry, citrus marmalade and a hint of apricot. Lively and well-balanced.

Ainoa was founded by two immigrants who came to Finland to make great wine. The numerous international awards their wines have been given are proof that from the Finnish forests can come some of the best wines on Earth.



Niepoort Late Bottled Vintage Port 2020

Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinto Cão, Tinta
Francisca, Tinta Amarela, Sousão, Tinta Roriz
Porto, Portugal

Sweet and intense. Rich and concentrated port wine, delivering ripe plums, blackberries, figs, dates and a touch of caramel sweetness. It's velvety yet structured, with smooth tannins, peppery spice and a balanced grip.

Finnair and Kyrö partnered several years ago. Kyrö made special batch of whiskey to celebrate Finnair's 100th anniversary in 2023 which was aged in barrels in Finnair Lounge at the Helsinki airport. On this flight you can experience Kyrö Vodka which was originally made and launched for Finnair.
